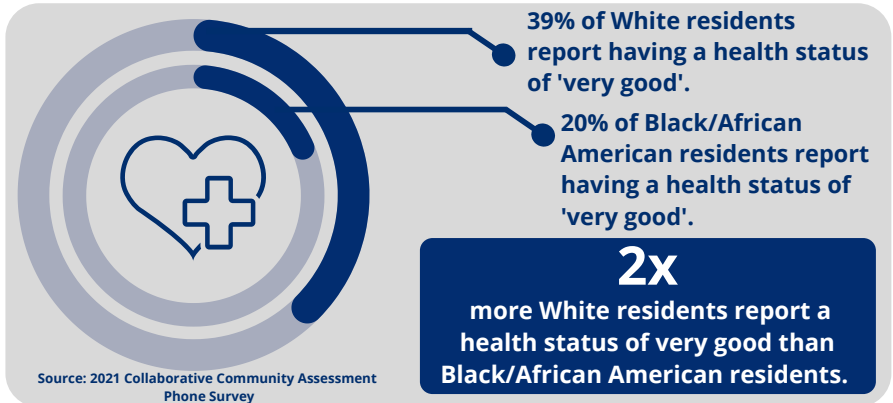

Average number of mentally unhealthy days in the past 30 days for Jackson County Residents

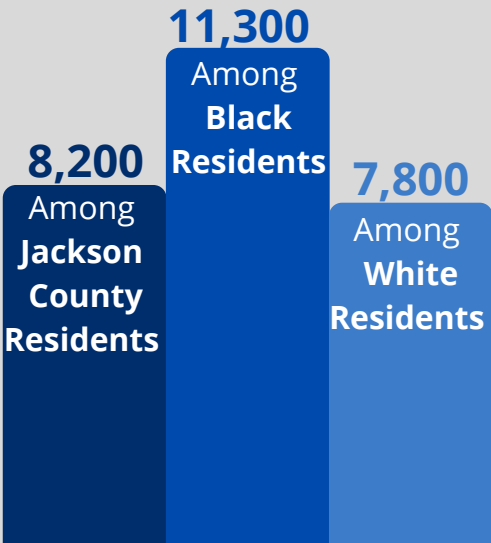

Potential Life Lost & Life Expectancy

Years of Potential Life Lost Due to Premature Death



- Premature death measures the risk of dying before age 75.
- The result is a rate per 100,000 lives.
- Premature death is a relatively rare event in most communities and is an important measure of poor health.

Years of potential life lost due to premature death across Michigan is 7,500.

Life Expectancy for Jackson County Residents

Black residents in Jackson County have a life expectancy **5 years shorter** than White residents.

Infant Mortality Rate

In Jackson County, Black infants are **5X** more likely to die before their first birthday than White infants.
